ORDER

In pursuance of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 12-8-2005 in Appeal (civil) No. 5041 of 2005 filed by P.A. Inamdar Vs. State of Maharashtra (AIR 2005 SC 3226), the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated. 09-05-2017 in Dar-us-Salam Educational Trust and Ors (Writ Petition(s)(Civil) No(s). 267/2017) and also as per the representation made in the letter 10th read above, it has been decided to issue orders effecting amendments to admission policy and seat matrix for the competent authority seats/ Management seats / NRI/ NRI sponsored seats in Unaided Minority Medical / Dental Colleges in the State for the Under Graduate Courses i.e., MBBS and BDS.

- 2. Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act No. 5 of 1983) and in partial modification of the Andhra Pradesh Un-aided Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules 2007, issued in G.O.Ms.No.272, HM&FW (E1) Department, dated:10.7.2006, as amended subsequently, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the Rules for admission into the Under Graduate Professional Courses in Medical and Dental in Un-aided Minority Professional Institutions in the State:-
- 3. The Government after careful examination have decided to amend the Andhra Pradesh Un-aided Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules 2007 issued in G.O.Ms.No.272 HM&FW(E1) Department, Dated: 10.7.2006, and as amended subsequently.
- 4. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the Extraordinary issue of the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, Dated:12-07-2017.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act No. 5 of 1983) the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Private Un-aided Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate

Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules, 2007 issued in G.O.Ms.No.272, HM&FW.(E1) Department, Dated: 10.7.2006 and published in the Rules supplement to Part-I, A.P. Gazette 12.07.2006.

AMENDMENTS

In the said rules,

I. For Rule 4 'Allotment of seats', the following shall be substituted:

The seats to be allotted in each Private un-aided Minority Professional Institutions under these rules, for admission of candidates shall be as:

Convenor Quota - Category - A seats (50% of the sanctioned intake of the seats):

Competent authority seats: These seats shall be filled in through the counselling by the committee constituted by competent authority as per merit from the candidates who are qualified at the common entrance test, NEET- UG for that year following the rules for allotment of seats to the Minorities concerned.

Management Quota - Category - B seats (35% of the sanctioned intake of the seats):

NEET-UG Ranking based management seats: The seats shall be filled through the counselling by the committee constituted by Competent Authority as per the merit from the candidates who are qualified at NEET-UG for that year as per the procedure as prescribed in this regard.

Management Quota - Category - C seats (15% NRI quota):

These seats shall be filled by committee constituted by Competent Authority as per the merit from the candidates who are qualified in NEET-UG for that year, under these rules.

In view of the making over of 50% of its total available seats in UG Courses, the Government of Andhra Pradesh, hereby exempts the private Unaided Minority institutions from the obligation, if any, of providing for reservations for either SCs, STs or backward classes separately, since the Government of Andhra Pradesh itself is providing for requisite 'reservations' in seats now available to the Government out of aforesaid 50% of seats, in UG courses in the institutions / Colleges of private managements. The private Unaided Minority Institutions need not make separate reservation under 15(5) or Article 371(J) of the Constitution of India. The Candidates from All over India are eligible for Management Quota Seats.

II. For Rule 5 'Authority for Admissions', the following shall be substituted:

Category -A seats (50% of the sanctioned intake of the seats), Category -B Seats (35% of the sanctioned intake of the seats) and Category -C seats (15% NRI quota) shall be filled by the committee for admissions constituted by the competent authority under these rules.

III. For Rule 6 (B), the following shall be substituted:6.(B) to fill up NEET Ranking based Management Seats.

- i. The Committee constituted by the competent authority shall fill up the seats.
- ii. A.P., Private Un-aided Minority Medical and Dental Colleges Managements Association shall nominate one member representative to the Committee of Admissions constituted by the Competent Authority.
- iii. The Committee for Admissions shall authorise one among them to issue notification in at least two leading News Papers calling for a single common application for admissions into the above seats in all the private un-aided minority medical and dental colleges. The Admission Process and

- Number of Seats under Management Quota shall be displayed in the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences Website.
- iv. The Candidates shall pay the prescribed Non- Refundable Application Fee, Counselling Fee and University Fee.
- v. Category B seats shall be filled by the committee constituted by the Competent Authority based on the merit obtained in NEET-UG and following rules framed for this purpose.
- vi. The Committee for Admissions shall authorise one among them to Notify the Venue, date, time of counselling for the Management Quota Seats.
- vii. The candidates who are qualified to seek admission as a consequence of obtaining rank in NEET-UG and desirous of seeking admission into the Private Un-Aided Minority Professional Institutions shall be called for the Counselling.
- viii. The admission shall be made in the following manner:
 - a. The committee shall prepare the merit list based on the NEET-UG Ranking.
 - b. In case of tie, the older candidate shall be given higher place in the merit order.
 - c. The candidate shall attend the counselling with all their original certificates. The Committee for Admissions shall select the candidate in the counseling by calling for candidates based on NEET –UG ranking and as per the seat matrix.
 - d. The candidates selected for admission into unaided private minority Professional colleges shall pay the prescribed fee in the form of demand draft drawn on any national bank in favour of "The Principal of the Respective College, where the seat was allotted. If a candidate fails to pay the fee on the day of selection, the selection will be cancelled forthwith and will be filled with subsequent selection by counselling as per the prescribed procedure.
 - e. The fee so collected in the form as mentioned above shall be kept with the college till the admission process is completed. Soon after the completion of the admission process, the fee so collected shall be transferred to the college concerned if any change in allotment.
 - f. Once a candidate secures admission to a particular college/course based on his/her option, no more claims to admission into other colleges/course be entertained during that academic year.
 - g. If a candidate after 1st counselling fails to report to the principals of respective colleges on or before the stipulated time, he / she shall be deemed to have forfeited the seat and all such category B and C (NEET ranking based management seats) unfilled seats shall be filled by conducting second counselling.
 - h. The Admissions through Counselling into Management Quota seats will be closed at the end of 2nd Counselling and the candidates who were admitted will be considered as the bonafide candidates of the respective colleges. The Fee paid by the candidates and the Original Certificates will be sent to the respective colleges.

- i. If candidates are not available to fill the local seats, the unfilled seats shall be filled with the non-local respective minority candidates, as per rules.
- j. All unfilled seats under Category A after final counselling and B and C after second counseling will be surrendered to the managements of individual colleges. Such seats shall be filled by the management of the individual colleges on merit through NEET-UG ranking following rules set out for Category C.
- k. The above rules shall be followed scrupulously. Any violation of the rules shall entail cancellation of admissions of the candidates concerned and the conduct of admissions afresh following the procedure etc.
- I. All the private Un-aided Minority Medical and Dental Colleges shall adhere to the above procedures scrupulously. Any deviation / malpractices thereof will entail severe disciplinary action by the competent authority.

IV. For Rule 6 (C), the following shall be substituted:

Category – C (NRI Quota seats) (15% of the total intake of the seats):

The candidates shall submit an affidavit to establish the bonafides that they are children /wards of bonafide NRI residents.
