NOTICE TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE 2ND PHASE WEB BASED COUNSELING FOR ADMISSION INTO MBBS COURSE UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA SEATS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-23

In continuation to this office notification, dated.05.11.2022, it is hereby notified the following in connection with 2nd Phase web based counseling for admission into MBBS course under Competent Authority Quota seats for the academic year 2022-23 for information of the candidates who have exercised one time options.

- As per the NEET UG Schedule 2022 notified by the MCC, DGHS, Government of India, the 2nd round of counselling should be completed by 28.11.2022.
- 3. <u>Candidates eligible for Phase-II counseling</u> (As per the one-time options already exercised).
 - a. As per the orders dated.22.07.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Contempt Petition (C) No.289 of 2022 and as per the Notice 12021/01/2022-MEC, dt.12-07-2022 of DGHS, HM&FW Govt. of India, New Delhi, the joined candidates up to round 2 of AIQ or State Quota shall not be eligible to participate in the further rounds for All India Quota or for State Quota from the academic year 2022-23 onwards.
 - b. Candidates who have exercised onetime options but could not get seat allotment in Phase-I of counselling.
 - c. Candidates who have reported in Phase-I counseling (except the candidates who availed retain option and opted to exit from the reported seats) will be considered for the available vacancies in the Phase-II counselling for upgradation / sliding to other college basing on the ONE TIME OPTIONS ALREADY EXERCISED BY THE CANDIDATES and will be considered as a part of Phase-II and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.

- d. As already notified, the candidates who have already opted to retain in the allotted seat of Phase-I (by submitting self-declaration) and also who did not opt for free exit will not be considered for up-gradation in next phase of counselling (as per the one time options already exercised), but will be retained in the existing seat and will be considered as a part of Phase-II (except for default sliding in the same college) and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- e. The candidates who are included in the final merit list of 2022-23 through addendum as per the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of AP and who have exercised options.

4. Candidates not eligible for Phase-II of counseling:

- a. The candidates who did not join in the allotted college in 1st phase counseling and who have opted to Exit from the reported seat of Phase - I will not be considered for Phase-II counseling.
- b. Candidates who have joined the course in Phase-II All India Quota / Deemed Universities Counseling are not eligible for Phase-II counselling as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) of Government of India.
- The selections will be made strictly as per the G.O.Rt.No.550, dated.30.07.2001 as amended vide G.O.Rt.No.111, dated.13.08.2019 and G.O.Rt.No.159, Higher Education (E.C) Department, Dated.13.11.2020.
- 6. Only Muslim minority candidates will be considered for competent authority quota seats in Un-aided Private Minority Medical colleges. If Minority candidates are not available then the seats will be converted to Non-Minority and will be filled with eligible candidates.

7. Allotments under Special Categories:

- a. The seats reserved for Sports & Games quota will be filled as and when the final priority list is received from the Sports Authority of Andhra Pradesh.
- b. As per the orders dated.22.07.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Contempt Petition (C) No.289 of 2022 and as per the MCC Notice, dated.12.07.2022, the candidates joined upto round-2 of AIQ / State Quota are not eligible to participate in the further rounds for All India Quota or for State Quota from the academic year 2022-23 onwards. Hence, the allotted candidates of Phase-I & Phase-II of counseling will not be permitted to upgrade in Special Category counseling of Sports & Games quota as and when those respective special category counsellings are held.

- c. The unfilled special category seats due to non availability of eligible candidates under respective special categories (except Sports & Games Quota) during this 2nd phase counseling, if any, will also be converted and filled as per rules, since the seats under special categories are Horizontal Reservation.
- 8. The Phase-I seat vacated because of the up-gradation (as per the ONE TIME OPTIONS ALREADY EXERCISED) during the course of Phase-II counselling will be added and allotted simultaneously to the next candidates as per the merit and rules. The candidates upgraded in Phase-II of counselling should compulsorily report at the upgraded college.
- 9. If a candidate is allotted a seat in MBBS course as per his/her options and does not join the course, he/she will not be eligible for that course in Mop-up phase of counseling to prevent seat blocking.
- 10. Candidates will receive the message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are also instructed to visit the website:<u>https://ugcq.ntruhsadmissions.com</u> for status of allotment.
- 11.Candidate can download the provisional allotment order on payment of University Fee Rs.10,600/- through payment gateway. The students can view the college wise list of selected candidates in the website. Candidates those who allotted in the Phase-I and paid university fee need not pay again.
- 12. If the joined candidate of Phase-I slides to other college during 2nd phase of counselling, the original certificates will be sent to the newly allotted college by the previous college after closure of admissions. The candidate has to report at the re-allotted college with downloaded allotment order and custodian certificate issued by the previous college and to pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.
- 13. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 14. Fresh allotment during Phase-II: Candidates who have been allotted a seat shall report at the allotted college within the reporting schedule by downloading the allotment order on payment of University fee of Rs.10,600/- along with all original certificates and pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.
- 15. Verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college during admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per University regulations.

- 16.As per G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2019, if any candidate wants to withdraw from the course after the closure of admissions in the middle of the course such candidate has to submit his/her request through the Principal of the college concerned along with course discontinuation fee of Rs.3,00,000/- for MBBS plus GST as applicable to the University by way of demand draft drawn in favour of the Registrar, Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences, payable at Vijayawada.
- **Note:** The requests received directly from the candidates for withdrawal from MBBS course will not be entertained under any circumstances. Any request shall be routed through Principal concerned only as per the G.O.Ms.No.72, HM & FW (C1) Dept, dated.15-07-2019.
 - 17.Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences does not entertain or support seat blocking/ cancellation of MBBS seats.
 - 18. In case any student is found involved in seat blocking, legal action will be initiated against such candidate.
 - 19. Decision of Competent Authority is final.
